Benalla - Information for Visiting Pilots and Crew

BAV welcomes you to Benalla

This document provides information to balloon teams to assist them enjoy their stay, and protect and promote ballooning in North East Victoria. Pilots please be sure to share this document with your crew.

The Balloon Association of Victoria was founded in 1985 and has since become one of Australia's most active balloon clubs. BAV has hosted the Nationals at <u>Benalla</u> in 1990, 2007, and 2009, and looks forward to hosting many events in the future. Benalla has hosted two World Gliding Championships and is sport aviation friendly.

Membership of BAV

If you are involved in hot air ballooning in any way, you can become a member of BAV. Single membership is \$40 and family membership is \$50. BAV Hut

The BAV hut is located within the Aeropark at the <u>Benalla Airport</u>, providing affordable accommodation for members and friends. There are 5 bunk rooms,1 room with a double bed, a kitchen and lounge/dining area. Toilet block & shower facilities are outside and shared with the Aeropark. The code for the toilet block can be found on the whiteboard. **Speed limit in the Aeropark is 5 kph.**

You must book the hut by calling Lu Michell (Treasurer) on 0414836913. The cost is \$15 per person per night for members and \$25 for non members. Children under 16 years are free. You need to BYO bedding and rooms are very cold in wintertime. Lu will provide you with the hut code when you book.

Heating and cooling is provided by the split system located in the common area. A woodfire heater is also available to use. There is WiFi, but it can be patchy - the password is on the whiteboard. Pets are not permitted in the hut, including the entry area. Please use the dishwasher and keep the common kitchen area tidy.

Upon leaving the hut, we ask that you vacuum your room and the common area and ensure the kitchen is clean and you take all food with you. For security, ensure the windows are closed, curtains drawn and doors locked. You can leave the electricity, power and fridge on. **Tip:** To work the oven, the clock must be on. The manual for the oven can be found under the cutlery draw opposite.

Landowner Relations

We welcome visiting pilots to our flying area and we ask you to be very respectful to landowners. You must obtain landowner permission when landing and launching and respect existing SZ's. Farmers prefer that their animals (particularly horses, lambs, calves, feedlots and intensive poultry) are not disturbed so use quiet burners and leave good space (500' overfly recommended) when near to livestock. Avoid landing in crop, seed or hay paddocks (rye grass hay in spring); not tearing up paddocks when wet (winter and spring); managing fire danger; and being biosecurity aware

Good practice is to carry a couple of bottles of wine or champagne and offer this to the landowner as appropriate. Goldrush Ballooning can supply a half dozen case of Brown Brothers Prosecco NV at cost (\$60) with prior request by email to <u>flights@goldrushballooning.com.au</u> - pick up at the BAV Hut.



Everyone has a role to play in biosecurity



Don't feed pigs meat, or food containing or that has touched meat



Avoid interacting with livestock or visiting a farm for 7 days after return from overseas

Wash clothes and boots before and after visiting farms or interacting with livestock

Talk to your vet if your animals or livestock are sick



If you have livestock, keep your PIC and biosecurity plan up to date

Benalla Airport (YBLA, ELEV 569ft)

The Benalla Airport is certified and operated by the Benalla Rural City Council, 03 5760 2600. There are a number of users on the airport including the <u>Gliding Club of Victoria</u> and the <u>Benalla Aviation Museum</u> amongst others - please be friendly, wave, say hello and promote the BAV and ballooning as part of the aviation community.

Pilots must have a **Balloon Aerodrome Endorsement** on their PP(B)P or be a CP(B)L holder to operate below 2,000ft and 3NM of Benalla. A copy of the **FAC** for Benalla can be found on the noticeboard in the hut. Please refer to the latest **ERSA** for the latest copy. Check **NOTAMS** - the aerodrome is often very wet on grassed areas during winter and should be avoided. You will also find a runway layout and satellite photo view on the noticeboard.

An airside access gate is electronically controlled and located on the west side of the airport in the car park, near the State Gliding Centre. An access token is required to operate the gate. Call the council and ask for an application form well in advance of your visit. Vehicles operated airside must be registered and in roadworthy condition and insured, must have a bright approved roof mounted flashing light (this is a good one - https://visionsafe.com.au/product/dome-led-beacon-by-visionsafe/) and (ideally) be monitoring Benalla CTAF VHF 125.6. Crew who do not hold an Aeronautical Radio Operator Certificate (AROC) are not permitted to transmit. Movement area speed limits are 20kh/h. Hi-Viz vests must be worn when airside.

Balloon launch: The airfield is usually quiet in the early morning but air ambulance is a frequent user of the airfield at any time of day or night. The afternoon is usually busy with glider and glider tug activity. We recommend to avoid flying over the 08/26 sealed runway so if you expect to be tracking in a northerly direction, the best place to launch is north of the sealed runway near the glider command hut. If you expect to be tracking southerly direction we recommend launching from the west side of the 35 grass runway. **Balloon landing:** The airfield is often used for balloon landings. We recommend landing on the grass runways and avoid the main sealed runway and movement areas (or move off as soon as possible).

CFA Fire Permit (needed November to March approximately - depends on the season)

Hot Air Ballooning during the fire danger period requires a permit from the CFA (Schedule 14). The Fire Danger Period may be declared as early as October and typically remains in place until the fire danger lessens, which could be as late as May. You must apply well in advance of your visit (3 weeks at least) and Information on permits and how to apply can be found here:

You must notify the Emergency Services Telecommunications Authority (ESTA) for each balloon flight, ideally **between 2 to 24 hours beforehand** using the online form provided in the information sent to you with your permit. If you are starting your flight, or changing location, within 2 hours, call **1800668511**. The operator will ask for your take off location, nearest cross road, duration of burn (flight), type of fuel used (propane), and permit number. Have this information ready as the operators can sometimes be busy with 000 calls.
